Parents, we have been watching the Covid-19 data closely and have noticed a considerable decrease in the spread of this virus in our community. This is good news as we feel that it is time to bring your children back into school for in-person learning.

We will remain remote this week, but beginning Monday, January 11, all students K-12 will once again attend school in-person, in classrooms. We will still have our Panther Virtual option for the second semester and if you are a parent with virtual students, unless you let us know by the end of this week, we will assume that you will have your children remain in Panther Virtual for the rest of the school year.

Please remind your children that we will be under the same safety and health protocols as we had before we went remote. This means everyone will wear masks and use hand sanitizer including when riding the bus.

As students return Monday, it is important for us to retrieve the Chromebooks they borrowed as we will need them for in-person instruction. Please have your children return these devices to school on Monday.
